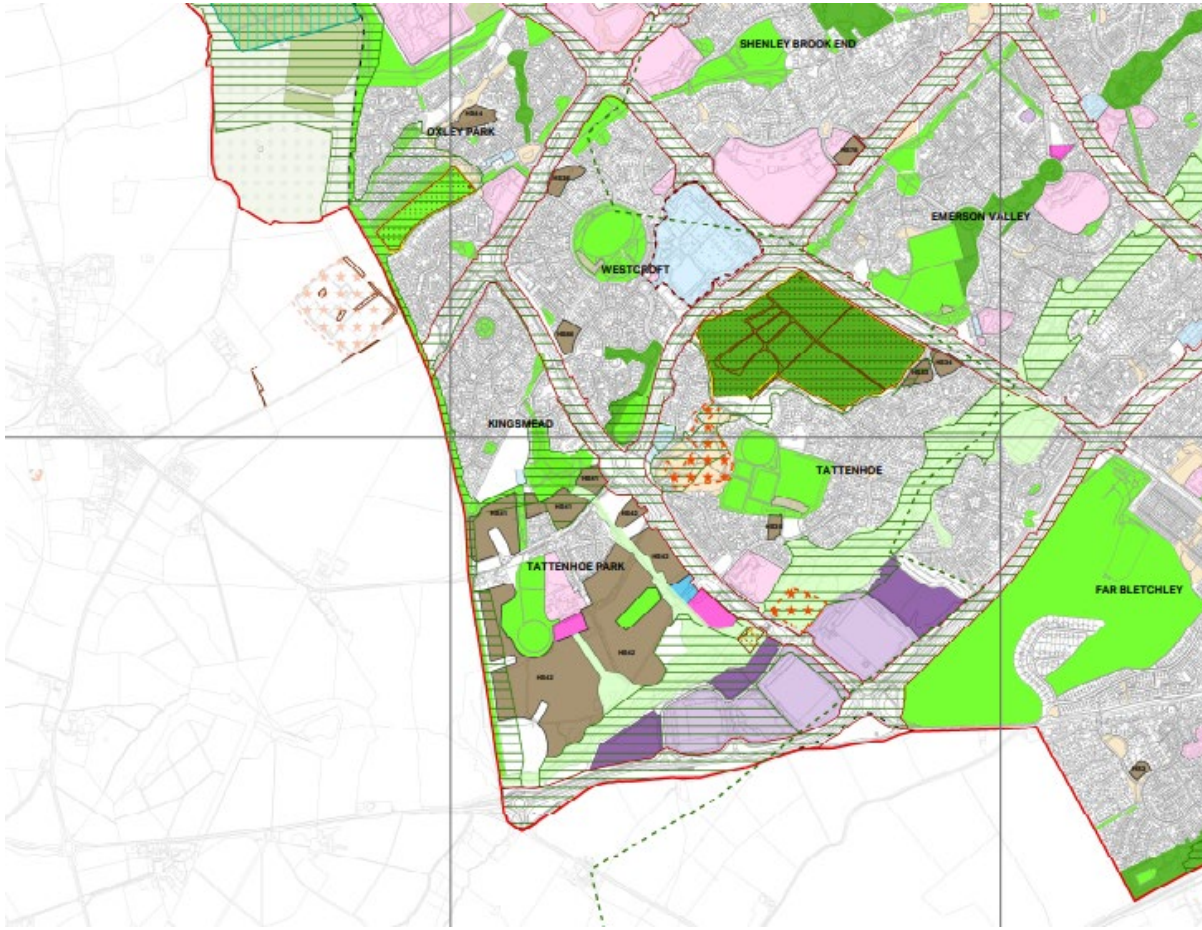
Plan MK: Policies
